ACTION REQUESTED	Consider recommending an amendment to the PY 2022 Action Plan to allocate \$35,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to Anoka County's Community and Government Relations to be used for staffing and service delivery costs directly related to carrying out CDBG housing rehabilitation loan program. In accordance with our Citizen Participation Plan, a 30-day public comment was held July 22, 2022 - August 22, 2022, with a public hearing scheduled for August 23, 2022
BACKGROUND	Anoka County Community Development department administers a CDBG-funded home rehabilitation loan program to income-qualified residents. If awarded, these CDBG funds will pay for staffing costs directly related to administering the county's single-family CDBG home rehabilitation loan program. Currently, the programs administrative expenses are paid with CDBG administrative / planning funds. This is a HUD allowable use of CDBG funds.
