 - b. Termination vs. Non-Renewal Definitions/Policy
 - c. Manufactured Homes-bank can’t reposes homes until this law is over
 - d. July 14th, 2021- New: Residential and Commercial landlords can file eviction actions where the tenant commits material lease violations.
 - i. Likely to see increase in evictions filed mid-July for material violations.
 - ii. Every judge is going to have a little difference interpretation of “material violations”
 - e. September 12th, 2021-New: Residential and commercial landlords can file non-payments eviction actions for those ineligible for rental assistance
