## **Andover Fatal Pickup Truck vs School Bus Crash**

On September 30, 2025, at approximately 6:59 A.M, the Anoka County Sheriff's Office, Andover Fire Department, and Allina EMS, responded to a report of a crash involving a school bus near 175th Ave NW and Roanoke St NW in the City of Andover.

Indications show that a pickup truck carrying a trailer was traveling northbound on Roanoke St NW when it crossed the center line and hit a school bus head on going southbound. Lifesaving measures were administered to the adult male driver of the pickup truck, however he was declared deceased at the scene.

The school bus had five student passengers at the time of the crash enroute to Anoka High School. The adult female driver and one of the students were transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The remaining students were picked up at the scene by their parents.

This incident is under investigation by the Minnesota State Patrol, Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No further information will be released at this time.
