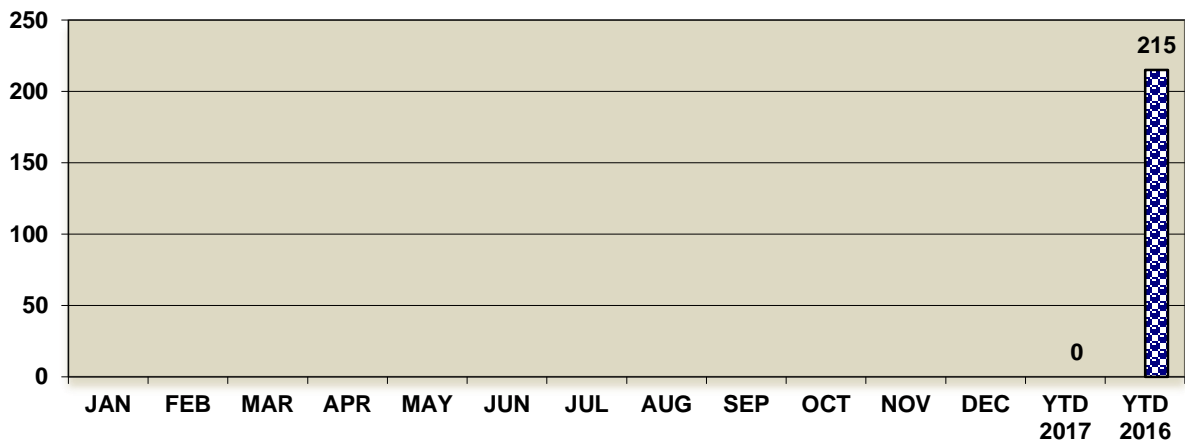

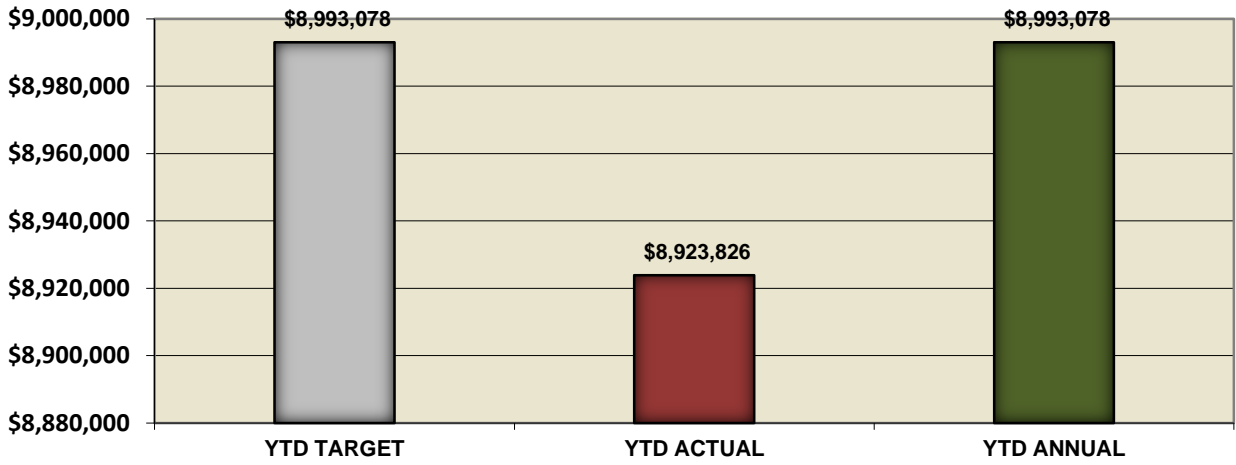
GOAL	STATUS

Develop a replacement plan for squad related equipment.	IN PROGRESS: Equipment inventory is complete. Research being completed on life expectancy of equipment.
Complete COA process with FAA for UAS program.	COMPLETED: Pilot training is being scheduled and will be completed by September 2016. 14 deputies will be trained in the COA and aircraft operations.
Dive Trailer Acquisition	IN PROGRESS: Waiting on funds to be approved through Emergency Management. Purchasing is prepared for bids once funds have been secured.
Establish a Mobile Field Force.	IN PROGRESS: Team leaders have been trained by St. Paul Police Department. In-house training is being prepared. All equipment has been ordered. 50% of equipment is mission ready.

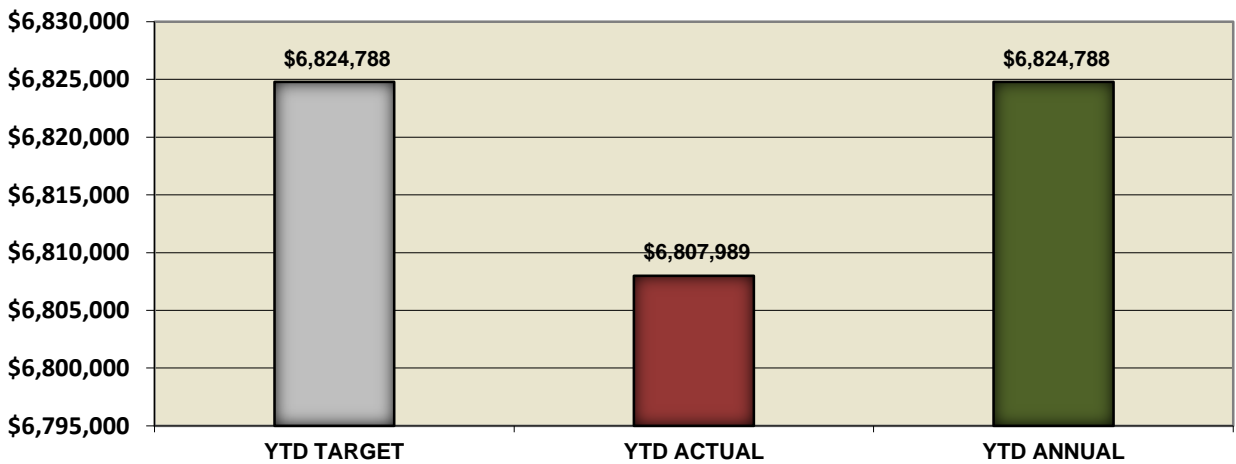

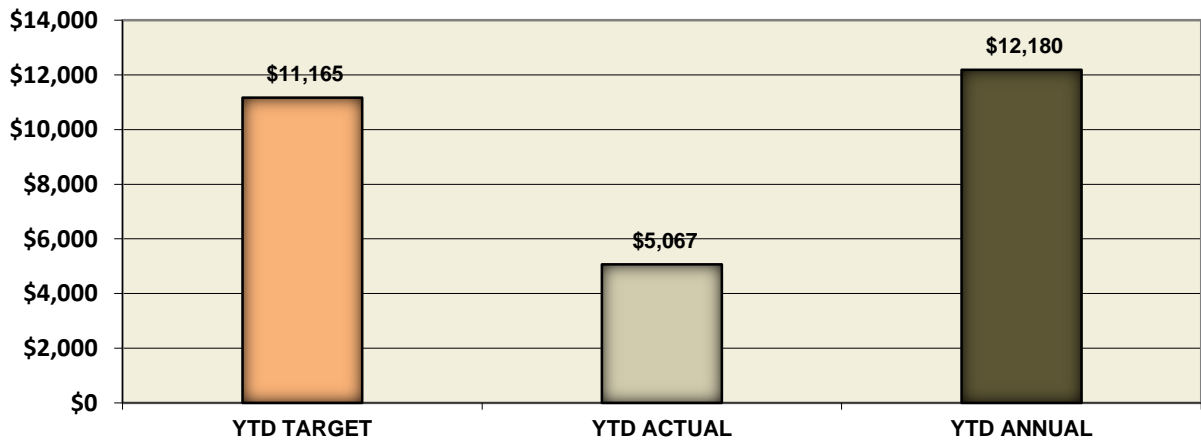

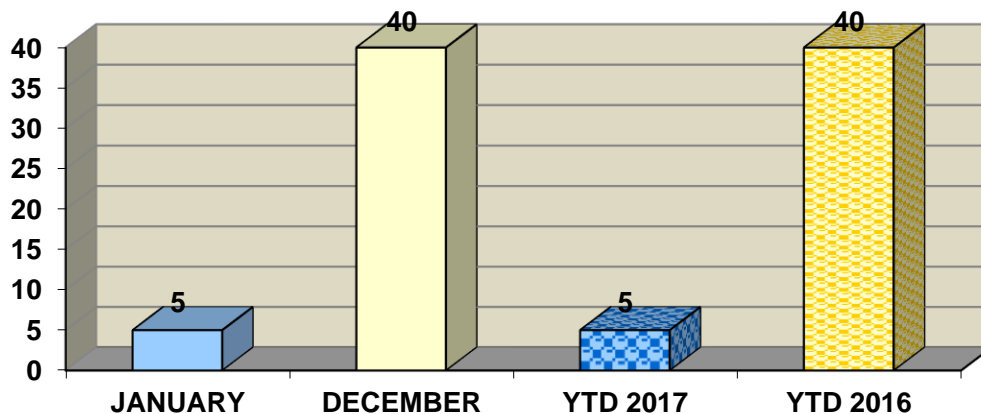
