Blaine Fatal Pedestrian vs. Motor Vehicle Crash

On October 25, 2021, at approximately 12:34 P.M., the Blaine Police Department, Spring Lake Park Blaine Mounds View Fire Department, and Allina EMS responded to a report of a pedestrian hit by a motor vehicle near 109th Ave NE and Flanders Ct NE in the city of Blaine.

Early indications show that a motor vehicle traveling westbound on 109th Ave NE hit an adult female walking a dog on the side of the road. Following the crash, the vehicle did not stop and left the scene of the incident. First responders performed life saving measures on the female, and she was transported via LifeLink III helicopter to a local hospital where she was pronounced deceased. The suspected vehicle was later located and there is no threat to the public at this time.

The investigation into the incident is still in the early stages by the Blaine Police Department, Minnesota State Patrol, Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
