

## What about dental care?

- Dental coverage is a part of your Medical Assistance
- Dental checkups are due every 6 months
- Your child's doctor will advise you to start dental checkups as soon as the 1st tooth appears, and no later than 12 months
- Your health plan or C&TC staff can help you find a dentist that will take your insurance

## What is the Child and Teen Checkups (C&TC) program?

Children and teens on Medical Assistance (MA) are automatically part of the C&TC program from birth until 21 years of age.

The C&TC program includes free checkups and follow-up care. Your family can also get help finding doctors, dentists, and community resources.

## My children aren't sick. Why do they need to visit the doctor for checkups?

Regular checkups (called Child and Teen Checkups or C&TCs) help children stay healthy by:

- Finding and treating health problems early
- Encouraging healthy habits
- Giving you a chance to ask questions about your child's health and development

C&TCs are also a perfect time to complete forms for Head Start, school, sports, daycare, or WIC.



## What is included in a Child and Teen Checkup?

The components of a C&TC are based on the age of your child, but often include:

- Measurements (height, weight, blood pressure)
- Vision and Hearing screenings
- Physical exam
- Developmental screening
- Health history
- Dental health
- Health education about healthy lifestyles, nutrition, parenting, behavior, and safety
- Mental health
- Vaccines and lab tests

A complete C&TC includes all of this and more!

0-1 month	12 months
2 months	15 months
4 months	18 months
6 months	24 months
9 months	30 months

Yearly ages 3-20

## How do I make an appointment?

Making an appointment is easy. Call your child's regular doctor or clinic and ask for a Child and Teen Checkup.
