

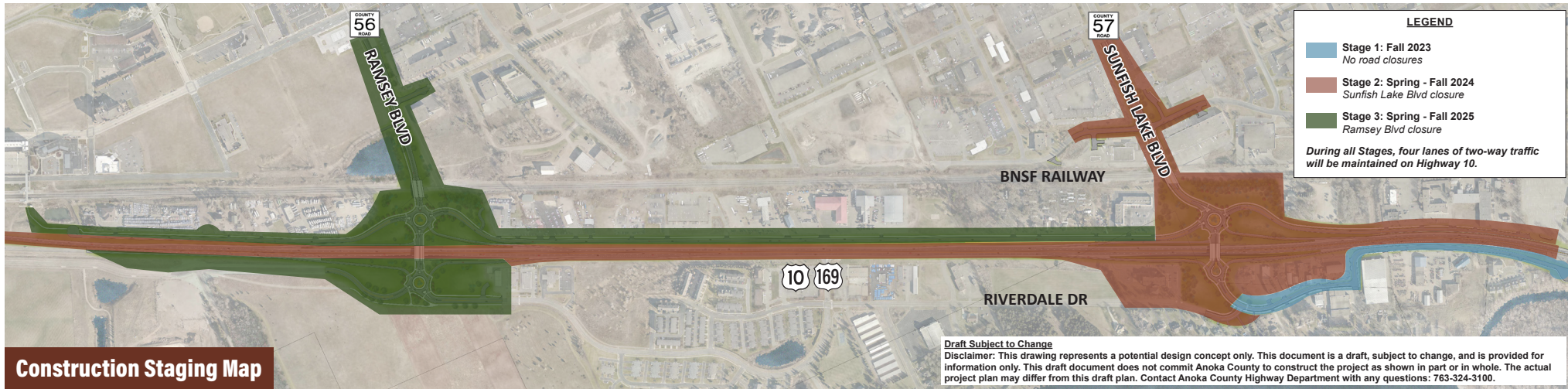


# Ramsey Gateway Highway 10 Project

## Open House Summary | June 29, 2022

**~47** open house attendees  
**4** public comments collected

Thank you to everyone who attended the June 29, 2022 open houses! Two in-person meetings were held at Ramsey City Hall, one for business and property owners and the other for the public. Information shared included the final project layout and options for public feedback on design aesthetics and construction staging plans. Materials and feedback opportunities were also provided online.



## Summary of Questions and Comments Heard

### How will local access be maintained during construction?

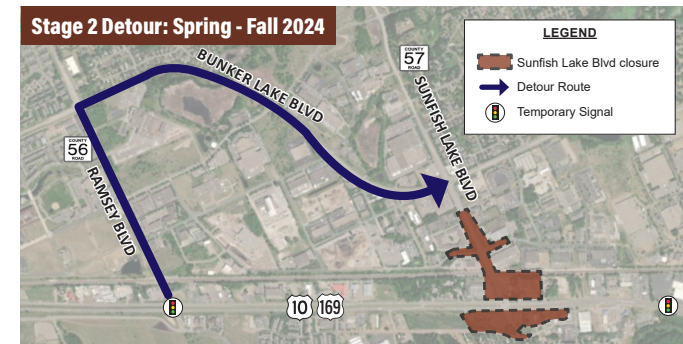
During all stages of construction, two lanes of traffic in each direction on Highway 10 will be maintained. Local access to businesses and private properties will be maintained, but at times may require a detour route. Both Stages 2 and 3 will require separate temporary closures of Ramsey and Sunfish Lake Boulevard, north of Highway 10, to complete construction of the BNSF railway overpasses and new interchanges (see figures to the right). During each closure, through traffic on Highway 10 will be maintained and access to north Ramsey and Sunfish Lake Boulevard will be provided along Bunker Lake Boulevard.

### What will the duration of local access limitations be?

The exact duration and schedule of temporary closures on Ramsey and Sunfish Lake Boulevards is not yet known. More information about the construction staging schedule and communication plan will be shared at the next project open house planned for Spring/Summer 2023.

Aside for questions about construction staging plans, there was much support shared for the final design plan and excitement for the project to be constructed!

Wood slat, metal frame benches.



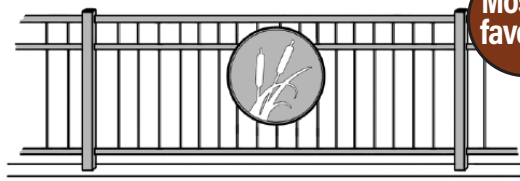

A final open house will be held in Spring/Summer 2023 to share construction staging and communication plans for activities to begin in Fall 2023 and be completed by Fall 2025.

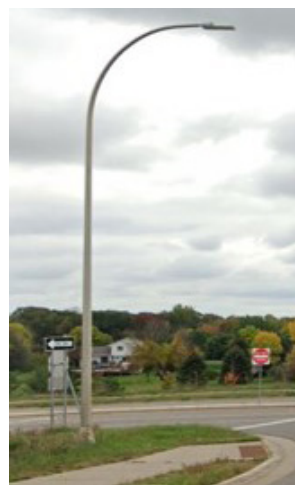
#### Bridge Railing & Pedestrian Lighting Aesthetics

Cutout railing accent.

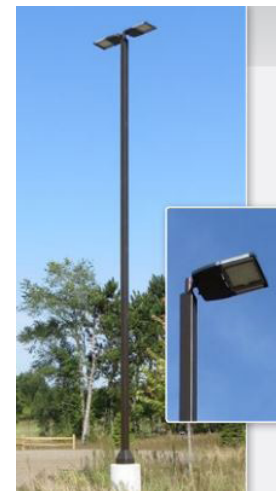

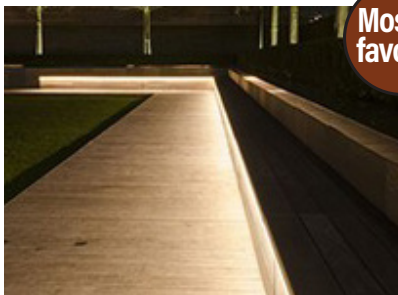


Lights at the roundabouts will match armstrong lights
