## ANOKA COUNTY VETERAN SERVICES TO ATTEND 2023 NACVSO TRAINING CONFERENCE

The Anoka County Veteran Services Office will not be scheduling appointments for the week of June 5-9 while our Veteran Service Officers attend the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers Training Conference.

## HOW TO TRACK VETERAN-RELATED LEGISLATION

As the 2023 session of the Minnesota Legislature nears the finish, there are a handful of bills relevant to Veterans living in Minnesota that could become law. To become law a bill must pass through both chambers, then be signed by the Governor. ## REMINDER: VISITS TO ANOKA COUNTY VETERAN SERVICES BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Reminder, Anoka County residents who are seeking assistance applying for Veteran or Survivor Benefits must schedule an appointment to meet with one of our Service Officers. We are no longer able to take clients on a walk-in basis. The best way to schedule an appointment is to call our office at (763) 324-4500 and speak with a Service Officer so they can explain to the client what supporting documentation they must bring with them to our office.

## PACT ACT RELATED CLAIMS

The PACT Act is perhaps the largest health care and benefit expansion in VA history. The full name of the law is The Sergeant First Class (SFC) Heath Robinson Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics (PACT) Act.

The PACT Act will bring these changes:

- Expands and extends eligibility for VA health care for Veterans with toxic exposures and Veterans of the Vietnam, Gulf War, and post-9/11 eras
- Adds more than 20 new presumptive conditions for burn pits and other toxic exposures
- Adds more presumptive-exposure locations for Agent Orange and radiation
- Requires VA to provide a toxic exposure screening to every Veteran enrolled in VA health care

- Helps VA improve research, staff education, and treatment related to toxic exposures

If you're an Anoka County resident and are a Veteran or survivor, and you believe the PACT Act affects you, contact Anoka County Veteran Services to schedule an appointment for assistance filing claims for PACT Act-related benefits.

## **ANOKA COUNTY VETERANS SUPPORT NETWORK**

Similar to how the Veterans Advisory Board operated, there will be quarterly meetings with stakeholders, and the Anoka County Veteran Services Office will serve as a facilitator for these meetings.
