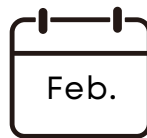
PROJECT MAP



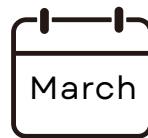
CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Road Reconstruction
- Addition of paved 8' shoulders
- Right turn lanes constructed at: Burns Pkwy, 184th, 187th, 188th, 190th, 194th, and 195th
- Left turn lanes constructed at 187th, 190th, and 194th,
- Storm water treatment

WHAT TO EXPECT

DETOUR - Signed detour using Sherburne County Rd 40 Cleveland St

CONSTRUCTION NOISE - Construction noise will be expected, and the Contractor will reduce impact as much as possible

DUST CONTROL - Water trucks will be used to maintain dust

TRUCK HAULING - Increased construction traffic

SAFETY - Follow in-place traffic control as directed. Follow all signs and travel with caution in construction zone

WORK HOURS

Monday - Friday 7am - 7 pm

Saturdays with City permission

RESIDENT ACCESS

Residents living in the construction closures will always have access to their house. Most side streets have two access points on CSAH 22 Baugh Street, one access point will be closed at a time to allow for resident access. Follow staging detour.

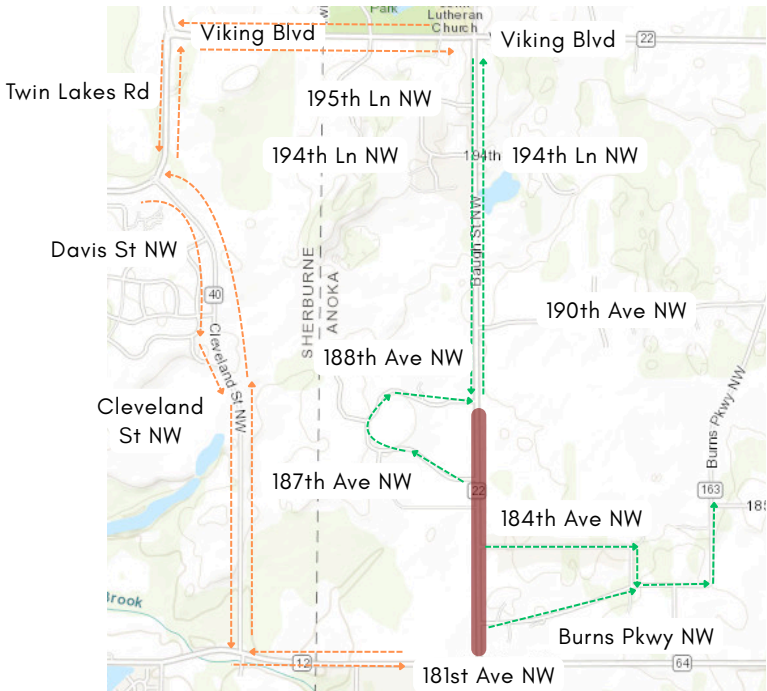

STAGING LAYOUT

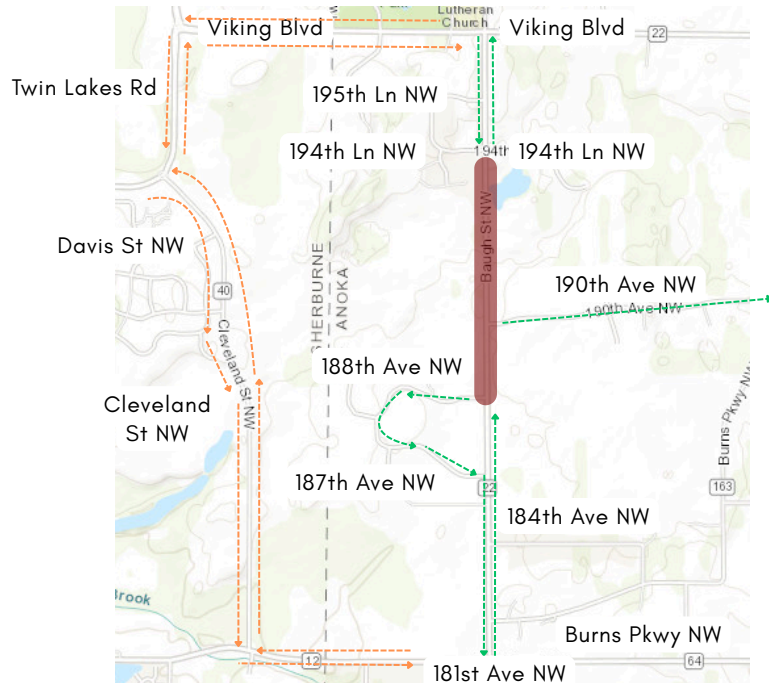
— Closed road

Construction from 181st Ave NW to 188th Ave NW

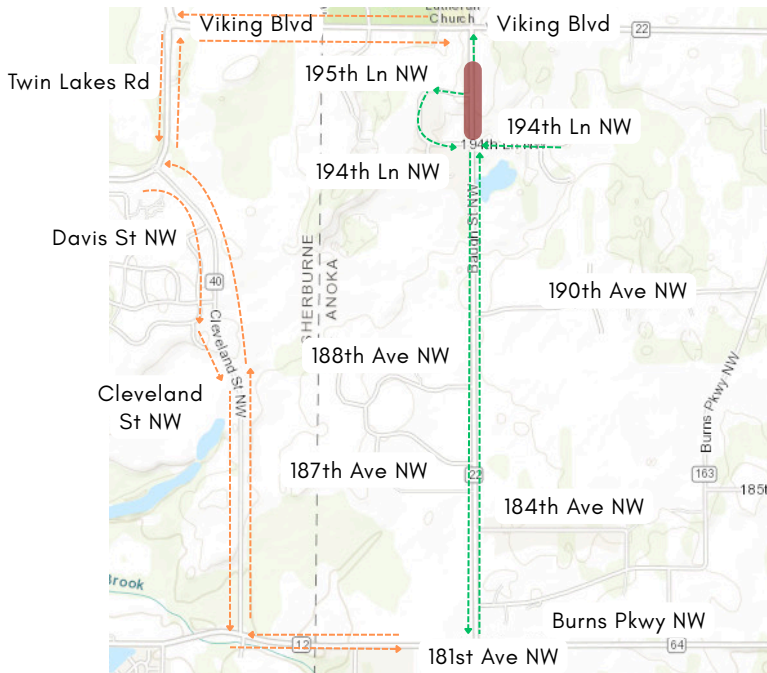
Traffic Impacts:

 Traffic detoured on Cleveland Street to Twin Lakes Road



STAGE 2

Construction from 188th Ave NW to 194th Ln NW

Traffic Impacts:
 Two way traffic north and south of the closure
 Traffic detoured on Cleveland Street to Twin Lakes Road



STAGE 3

Construction from 194th Ln NW to Viking Blvd

Traffic Impacts:
 Two way traffic south of the closure
 Traffic detoured on Cleveland Street to Twin Lakes Road
