



Diapering

- ❖ Diapering cannot occur in the food preparation area
- ❖ A non-absorbent surface (e.g. plastic diaper bag changing pad, plastic placemat) must be used
- ❖ Disposable wipes must be used whether a child is wet or soiled
- ❖ The changing surface must be disinfected with bleach water solution (two tsp. bleach to one quart of water) or an approved bleach alternative after each diaper change, unless using disposable pads for each diaper change.
- ❖ A covered diaper disposal container must be available in an area that doesn't require going outside
- ❖ Wet and dirty diapers may NOT be placed in the kitchen garbage

Hand Washing

With soap and water, dried on paper towels
(Hot water cannot be more than 120°)



Caregivers:

- ❖ After each diaper change
- ❖ After helping child with toileting
- ❖ After washing the diaper changing surface
- ❖ After wiping kids' noses
- ❖ Before food preparation

When?

- ❖ After toileting
- ❖ After playing outside
- ❖ Before eating
- ❖ After eating
- ❖ After naptime
